- I have the right to have the nature of the charges and the possible penalties explained to me;
- I have the right to an attorney, the right to a reasonable continuance to secure and consult with an attorney, and if I cannot afford an attorney the Court will appoint an attorney to represent me without cost to me;
- I have the right to bail for a bailable offense;
- I cannot be forced to make a statement at any point in the proceedings; but that any statement made by me is recorded and may be used against me;
- 5. I have the right to have my case tried by a jury or judge;
- I have a right to a reasonable continuance of my trial if I request:
- I have the right to confront any witnesses who testify against me;

- 10. A guilty plea is a complete admission of the truth of the facts in the complaint and of my guilt of the charge(s);
- 11. A no contest plea is an admission of the truth of the facts in the complaint but not an admission of guilt, but permits the Court to make a guilty or not guilty finding. Such a plea cannot be used against me in any future civil or criminal proceeding arising out of the same set of circumstances;
- 12. If I enter a plea of Guilty or No Contest, I waive all of these rights and the Court will impose sentence without unnecessary delay:
- 13. If I am not a United States citizen, pleading Guilty or No Contest may lead to deportation, exclusion from admission to the United States, or denial of naturalization;
- 14. If I am on probation or parole, a plea of Guilty or No Contest may violate the terms of my probation/parole;
